Last year - £12,158
This Year - £20,145
The Council had set aside funding to complete a project to build two new bus shelters on Bath Road.
Box 2 – Precept
Last year - £13,891
This year - £15,350
Very small increase in precept just to keep pace with the rising costs of everything.
Box 3 – Other receipts
Last year - £4,673
This year - £808
Last year the Council had two large 'other receipts' from a website grant $(£1,145)$ and fundraising money for a bus shelter $(£3,200) = £4,345$ on top of its normal 'other receipts'.
Box 4 – Staff Costs
Last year - £3,571
This year - £4,927
Last year the Councils HMRC account was in credit, so figure would have been higher. Going forward the amount of work a Parish Clerk is expected to do is increasing and so does the cost of employing one.
Box 6 – Other payments
Last year - £7006
This year - £17,888
The Parish Council had an exceptionally active year, installing 8 new dog bins, 5 new grit bins, two new bus shelters and reconditioning the Village Pump.
